COUNTY OF SLIGO.

The County of Sligo is bounded on the North by the Atlantic Ocean; E., Leitrim; S., Roscommon and Mayo; W., Mayo. Greatest length: N. and S., 38 miles; greatest breadth, E. and W., 41 miles; comprising an area of 452,356 acres, of which 74,508 are under tillage, 237,536 in pasture, 7,678 in plantations, 120,819 waste, bog, mountain, &c.; and 11,815 under water. The coast is indented by Sligo and Killala Bays. Near it are the islets of Innismurry, Oyster, and Coney. The surface has much mountain and much level ground. The soil, in many parts, is a light sandy loan; in others it is deep and rich; many patches of bog are interspersed. The subsoil in the level country is limestone. The Moy forms part of the W. boundary of the county. The foughs are—Gill. Arrow, Gara, Talt, Easky, and several smaller. The occupations are agricultural; coarse woollens and linens are manufactured.

Originally-about the 13th century-the Province was divided into two counties, the county of Connaught and the county of Roscommon, the former comprising the present counties of Clare, Galway, and Mayo, and the latter the present counties of Roscommon, Leitrim, Cavan, and Sligo, with the portion of Donegal between the Drowes and the Erne. In the 16th century the Province was divided into counties as they now exist. At the time of the formation of the County Sligo the northern boundary was the river Erne, but subsequently a memorial was presented to the Government applying as follows:-"For a grant of that small part of the County of Sligo which lies between the end of Lough Erne and the sea, as they intend to have a market town on the south side at Ballike, and from thence three miles nearer the sea to erect a strong corporation; this part of Sligo contains about three miles, being a piece very convenient adjoining the sea for the necessary use of the inhabitants of that corporation for bringing in or transporting their commodities." The boundary of the county was changed, the County of Leitrim getting the narrow strip of seaboard which now appears on the map.

The county is divided into 6 baronies, and contains 37 parishes, 1,260 town-lands, having a population in 1901 of 84,083; males, 41,849; females, 42,234 (Roman Catholics, 76,146; Protestant Episcopalians, 6,415; Presbyterians, 662; Methodists, 518; others, 342), or 17,167 families, inhabiting 17,049 houses; also 816 uninhabited, and 19 building. It is in the conserved of Achonry and Elphin, with portions in Killala and Ardagh. The conserved of Sligo has 10,870 inhabitants; Ballymote, 997; and Tobercury, 871.

The county returns 2 members to Parliament. Registered Electors, 1903—North Division, 8,446; South Division, 7,505; with 17 polling places. It is in the Connaught Circuit. The Assizes are held at Sligo, and Quarter Sessions at Ballymote, Easky, and Sligo. There are 14 Petty Sessions Districts within the county, and portions of 3 others. Three Poor Law Unions—Dromore West, Sligo, and Tobercurry—are wholly within the county, and parts of the Unions of Ballina and Boyle. The Constabulary force consists of 229 men. The county is within the Dublin military district; and, in conjunction with the cos. Galway, Leitrim, Mayo, and Roscommon, forms No. 68 Sub-district, the Brigade Depot of which is at Galway.
